

Essex Pride Dog Show 2018

the rules

Essex Pride is holding its annual dog show on the day of the Essex Pride event in Central Park Chelmsford on Saturday 16th June 2018.



This is your chance for you and your dog to show off how fabulous they are, and also support Essex Pride in the process.

How to enter:

All you need to do is fill in the entry form (you can download it from this web page) and bring it along with you on the day. Spare entry forms will be available if you lose yours/ don't have a printer.

You may enter your dog for up to 4 of the categories below:

- Most handsome hound/beautiful bitch
- Cutest puppy (under 12 months)
- Best veteran (over 9 years of age)
- Waggiest tail (happiest dog)
- Best dressed (including fancy dress)
- Cleverest trick
- Dog the judge would most like to take home
- The sit and stay sausage challenge.

All category winners will then be entered to win the special prize for best in show.

What will I (my dog) win?

There will be prizes available for all winners and rosettes for runners up (up to 4 places).

Do I have to pay to enter, and how much?

A suggested donation of £1 per entry (or £3 for all 4) should be paid to the dog show team on the day of the event.

When can I enter?

Registration for the event will be from 12:00 until 2:30pm and the event, including judging will start from 2:40 up to 4:30.

Other important points to note:

- The event is open to all but we do ask that children under the age of 14 are supervised by an adult and that they are competent to handle your pet safely (this includes the adults too!).
- The park is open for your dog(s) throughout the day but please ensure that you keep your pet under control and on a lead throughout the time you are at Essex Pride.
- If you are aged over 13 you will have to have purchased a wristband in order to come to Essex Pride.
- Please bring your own means to clear up after any mess your dog may generate (bring poop bags!)
- Please also bring water for your pet, especially if it is a hot day.

The Essex Pride dog show is meant to be a fun event so please do treat it as such and do not be too upset if the judges decide your dog is not the best.

We reserve the right to refuse entry to the show and this right is at the discretion of the show judges.
